

## Rules and Conditions

1. Your signature on an entry shall be construed as acceptance of the rules.
2. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, add or amend any of the classes as they see fit, condition or the entry is refused. If the event is cancelled we will rescheduled for another date.
3. The Organisers, Officers, Servants and Agents shall be under no liability for injury, loss or damage, however occasioned, suffered by competitors, spectators their property, servants or horses in connection with, or arising out of this competition. Each entrant must indemnify the Organisers against any legal action that may arise out of or during this competition.
4. Entry fees are non-refundable after the close of entries date, subject to a valid Vet or Doctors certificate. All entries must be supported by the appropriate entrance fee.
5. The competition will be run under the BRC rules. A copy of the rulebook is available on the BHS Bookshop and will be available to view on the day. Only tack acceptable under these rules will be allowed.
6. The decision of the judge is final. All objections must be lodged with the show secretary within 15 minutes of the incident accompanied with £20, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld or forfeited if not sustained.
7. All riders must wear approved headgear while mounted, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at a minimum of three points: standards include BSN 1384, PAS015 or prefix FEI or ASTM.
8. The judge will eliminate any competitor seen to be misusing whip, equipment or saddlery or acting in an abusive manner to any horse/ pony or other person.
9. Reasonable precautions will be taken at the competition to ensure the health and safety of all persons present. For these reasons, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and obey the instructions of the Organisers, officials and stewards.
10. No horse/pony under the age of four may compete and only horses/ponies competing may be ridden on the show ground.
11. Stallions may compete in all classes at the organiser's discretion. All stallions must wear 'stallion' disc.
12. Horse/ ponies must be present at the time allocated. If the judge is dissatisfied at the rate at which competitors are presenting themselves they may issue a public warning. At the end of that interval, a second public warning will be announce and if there is till no competitors coming forward to start, they may declare the competition closed.

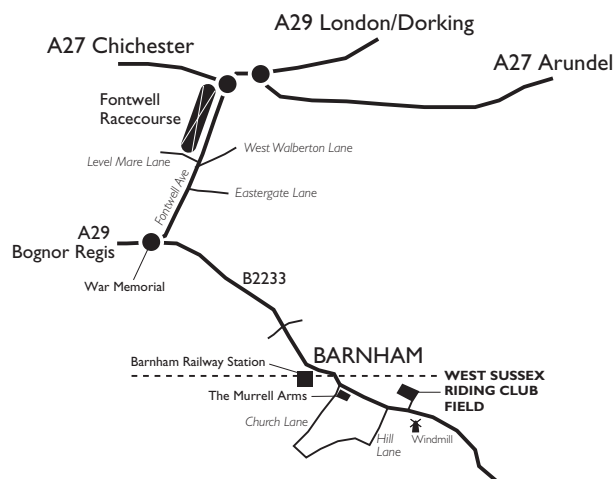
## How to find the Club Field
